WHAT IS HANDICAMP?


Handicamp is foremost an opportunity every year for up to twenty four 18 to around 38 year old adult people with mild to moderate intellectual and/or physical challenges to enjoy fun and fellowship, to grow through new experience, and to involve themselves in a range of activities they might not normally partake. Secondly, it provides respite to their normal carers, who most commonly are family members.

Handicamp has a history of 18 years, with about 450 campers attending.

Every camper is matched with a full time, generally inexperienced, but always voluntary live in same gender carer.

It is the sole responsibility of the carer to ensure the welfare of the camper and do everything in their power to see they have a great experience.

<p>If your form is in early (first in – first come) then there is a very good chance you will be asked to attend. Our only possible problem is meeting the required balance of male and female people to match campers.</p> <p>Forms are due in (by the Rotary club) by 1st March. You will be advised within two weeks after.</p>

The person who completed the nomination form (Form E) with you will also arrange transport at no cost for you (if required).

You may prefer to arrange your own transport. There is space to park your car at Handicamp. You will not be asked to transport a camper.

The arrival time is between 12pm and 2pm Saturday 10th April. The departure time is between 8am and 10am Friday 16th April (after your camper has departed).

WHAT COULD YOU DO FOR US AT THE END OF HANDICAMP
